As part of FDOT's long-term SR 16 improvement plans, this project, located in Bradford County, enhances safety and mobility for all modes of transportation while increasing the service life of SR 16. The enhancement includes the resurfacing, rehabilitation, and restoration of the existing roadways. Other improvements include base work, shoulder widening at various locations, sidewalk replacement, ADA compliance, drainage improvements, guardrails, signing and pavement marking, and retrofitting signalized intersections.
